Responsibilities

The successful candidate may be assigned field work in all four seasons throughout Canada on projects lasting up to four consecutive weeks. Field work will mainly include: (a) collecting surface till samples and boulder prospecting; and (b) logging and sampling overburden on a reverse circulation drill rig.

When not on a field assignment the candidate will work in ODM's dynamic laboratory and office environment and be involved with: (a) binocular microscope logging of heavy mineral concentrates and rocks including bedrock chip samples; (b) planning field programs; and (c) assisting with interpretive reports.

- P.Geo. or Geoscientist-in-Training accreditation (required).
- Good knowledge of: (a) mineralogy; (b) ore deposit models including gold, diamond and base metals; and (c) Quaternary geology.

- Report writing experience.

- Capable of using a microscope for extended periods.
